Please ensure that you keep to our pace of play rules:

- 1. Most players are now in the draw in order that they will finish. Once you have finished your last scoring hole, you MUST NOT play any extra holes. However, you MUST stay with your group (without playing) until everyone in that group has finished.
- 2. When you approach the green and your ball is on the green, take your bag to the exit point so that you can leave the green and collect your bag enroute to the next tee.
- 3. Mark your scorecard away from the green and preferably on the next tee. This will allow the group behind to play up. (They cannot do this until it is safe for them to do this. If you are still at the green it is not safe for them to hit.)

- 4. Do everything you can to keep up with the group in front of you.
- 5. When one person has finished in your group, they must stay with your group until everyone is finished but they must not play any more holes.
- 6. When everyone is finished in your group it is imperative that you get your cards to me as soon as you possibly can. Playing extra holes is strictly forbidden!
- 7. The above rules are to ensure the presentation can happen as promptly as possible and also to look after those members that are playing behind our event. Let's think about how our actions affect other people.
